

Appendix A
Conjugation of βαίνω and γινώσκω

Two very common verbs, βαίνω and γινώσκω, have irregular second aorist system. Their principal parts are as follows:

βαίνω, βήσομαι, ἔβην, βέβηκα to come, go
γινώσκω, γνώσομαι, ἔγνων, ἔγνωκα, ἔγνωσμαι, ἐγνώσθην to know

In both verbs, the aorist is conjugated as if it were from an athematic verb, as follows:
