II. Statement of Research Interests

My research and teaching interests are in the realm of child and adolescent developmental psychopathology. Although my interest in anxiety-related processes spans the life course and I have examined such processes at various stages of development (e.g., young adults, toddlers), my primary interest is in early portion of the life-span. Specifically, I study how specific diatheses, such as individual vulnerability variables and affect regulation processes, in the context of fear-relevant stress, contribute to the development of panic disorder (PD) and related anxiety pathology among adolescents. For a variety of reasons, adolescence appears to be an important developmental period during which vulnerability variables are transformed into anxiety-related psychopathology. Accordingly, my research program is oriented toward developing a developmentally-sensitive risk factor model for PD. To this end, I have examined the role of: a) individual-difference reactivity variables, such as behavioral inhibition sensitivity and anxiety sensitivity; b) emotion regulatory variables, such as worry, emotion suppression, and substance use, and c) developmentally-relevant stressful life events (e.g., fighting with parents) as they relate to the pathogenesis of PD. A diverse array of methodologies is used in my laboratory, including laboratory-based biological challenge, self-report, multi-informant, and interview data, and prospective research designs. Ultimately, I expect this risk factor research will culminate in a prevention program for PD among adolescents.
