Results of the Formula SAE – Australasia event.

Cooperative efforts between SAE Australasia, SAE International and local sponsoring companies made the first Formula SAE - Australasia event a success. The event took place December 8th, 9th and 10th at the Ford You Yangs Proving Ground in Victoria, Australia.

North Carolina A & T State, Rochester Institute of Technology, and the University of Texas Arlington represented the United States during the three day competition. University of Texas Arlington took home the first place overall award for the Open Class of events and the University of NSW / SW Institute of Technology finished first in the Australian class.
